

POP – Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) Declaration

POPs are organic substances that persist in the environment, accumulate in living organisms and pose a risk to our health and the environment.

POPs can be transported by air, water or migratory species across international borders, reaching regions where they have never been produced or even used.


The continuous release of POPs into the environment have been seriously concerned by the EU since regulation No 850/2004 of the European Parliament entered into force in 2004.

Finally in 2019 the POPs regulation was recast into Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 of the European Parliament and of the Council in 2019. This Regulation implements the Stockholm Convention and therefore includes compliance with the Stockholm Convention.

We will continue to check with its suppliers to ensure that this information remains updated.
